### **About the Festival**

This is the **58<sup>th</sup> Annual Anacortes Arts Festival**, to be held **August 2nd-4th**. Our Festival has approximately 260 booth artisans, 26 food vendors, 3 stages with entertainment, a fine art exhibition at the Port, a working artist area, a beer garden, Pub at the Port and Wine Bar.

## **Emergencies**

If there is an emergency, please call 911. If someone is in need of first aid, we have a tent located at 5<sup>th</sup> and Commercial. Please notify a lead volunteer at your work station and we will make sure the necessary actions are taken for the severity of the emergency. Several areas throughout the Festival also have first aid kits on site.

## **What to Wear**

A 2019 Festival t-shirt will be provided for our volunteers along with a name badge. We realize that the weather can vary, so please bring a jacket or sweatshirt if the weather looks to be questionable. If the weather is hot, sunblock and a water bottle will be needed. Volunteers are on their feet for several hours, so don't forget to wear comfortable shoes.

## **Volunteer Check-in**

All volunteers should check in with a lead volunteer in their scheduled area (please see below). They will answer questions about your position and guide you to the location you will be volunteering in, if you are uncertain. Bring only what you need to the event and if possible keep your belongings such as phone and wallet on you.

**Booth Sitters** – Check in 5<sup>th</sup> and Commercial next to Gere a Deli

**Docents** – Check in at the Port Transit Shed at the end of Commercial Ave. on the water

**Hideout Bar** – Also known as the 'beer garden' on 3<sup>rd</sup> and Commercial Ave. (next to stage)

**Information Booth** – Located on 5<sup>th</sup> and Commercial Ave. (under the blue tent)

**Lunch Delivery** – Check in 5<sup>th</sup> and Commercial next to Gere a Deli

**Port Pub** – Port Transit Shed dock at the end of Commercial Ave. on the water

**Reunion Wine Bar** – Located on 10<sup>th</sup> and Commercial Ave. (next to the stage)

**Working Artist Area** – Located between 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> and Commercial Ave.

**Youth Area** – Located on 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Commercial Ave.
